SAUDIA CARGO PARTNERS WITH CHINA CARGO AIRLINES

Additionally, the partnership will deliver comprehensive cargo solutions to clients, encompassing advanced cold chain services and efficient road freight connectivity.

DP WORLD AND VIMC LINES LAUNCH THE MEKONG EXPRESS

DP World, in partnership with VIMC Container Lines Joint Stock Company (VIMC Lines)has launched



has launched the Mekong Express, a new domestic sea-river transport route connecting the Can Tho (Cai Cui) and Cai Mep ports.

Operating twice a week, the barge service reduces transit times of 48 hours by the river ways to just 15 hours via a combination of river and sea routes, a 70% improvement. While the previous journey covers approximately 367 km, the coastal route is significantly shorter at around 200 km, making it a faster, more sustainable and cost-effective solution for cargo owners across Vietnam.

Designed to support dry and cold chain logistics, the Mekong Express can transport up to several hundred TEUs per voyage and is capable of handling a large number of refrigerated containers. The partners plan to expand the route to include a call at the Saigon Premier Container Terminal (SPCT), which is operated by DP World and a call at Saigon Hiep Phuoc Port under the Vietnam Maritime Corporation (VIMC).

ETIHAD AIRWAYS CELEBRATES FIRST FLIGHT TO ATLANTA

Etihad Airways, the national airline of the United Arab Emirates, has touched down in Atlanta for the first time, expanding its U.S. footprint and connecting the cultural and commercial heart of the U.S. Southeast with Abu Dhabi and beyond. The launch marks another milestone in Etihad's North American expansion.

Etihad's first flight from Abu Dhabi's Zayed International Airport to Atlanta's Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport touched down on 2 July, making Atlanta the fifth U.S. gateway in Etihad's global network, joining New York City, Chicago, Washington D.C., and Boston. Guests travelling from Abu Dhabi benefit from the convenience of the United States Customs and Border Protection (CBP) Preclearance facility at Zayed International Airport – the only one of its kind in the region. This allows passengers to clear U.S.immigration and customs before departure, arriving in the United States as domestic travellers and saving valuable time on arrival.

The newly launched route meets the growing appetite for travel between the UAE and the US, catering to business travellers, vacationers, and those visiting friends and family.
