DP World and SailGP have announced a new global logistics partnership that will see the company oversee the transport and delivery of the global racing championship's annual calendar of events.



Powered by its global network of 1,15,000 employees in 78 different countries, DP World will provide comprehensive end-to-end logistics for SaliGP across five continents, managing all sea freight, courier services and route optimisation solutions. Its network of storage handling, trucking, rail, and barge transport capabilities will also be on hand to support the delivery of the racing schedule.

ETIHAD AIRWAYS' AIRBUS A380 TAKES CENTRE STAGE AT THE FORMULA 1 ETIHAD AIRWAYS ABU DHABI GRAND PRIX

Etihad Airways iconic Airbus A380 took centre stage with a fly-by directly above Yas Marina Circuit to mark the start of the Formula 1 Etihad Airways Abu Dhabi Grand Prix 2024.

Minutes before the start of the final race in the annual Formula 1 calendar, Etihad's iconic Airbus A380 superjumbo flew over the starting grid. At 500 ft above the ground, this is one of the lowest altitude fly-bys Etihad has performed over the circuit.

This year's fly past was operated by Captain Adel Al Zubaidi as pilot in command, Captain Harris Kynigos, Captain Ziad El Nady, Captain Azizan Othman.

ABU DHABI AND ARCHER ANNOUNCE AGREEMENT WITH CROSS-INDUSTRY STAKEHOLDERS TO LAUNCH FIRST COMMERCIAL ELECTRIC AIR TAXI FLIGHTS

Archer Aviation Inc. (ACHR) announced that it has entered into a multiparty collaboration agreement with the key entities of the UAE to advance the establishment of electric air taxi operations in Abu Dhabi.

The agreement aims to formalize the cooperation between all UAE and Abu Dhabi stakeholders in preparation for the launch of the first commercial eVTOL flight.

The agreement was signed under the auspices of the Smart and Autonomous Systems Council (SASC), in the presence of

His Highness Sheikh Hamdan bin Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Deputy Chairman of the Presidential Court for Special Affairs.

Under the agreement, the goal is for Archer Aviation to be the first manufacturer of vertical electric vehicles in the Middle East and North Africa (MENA) region and will launch the first commercial flying taxi operations in the Emirate.

MAWANI ADDS EMIRATES SHIPPING LINE'S 'EJBS' SERVICE TO JUBAIL COMMERCIAL PORT

The Saudi Ports Authority (Mawani) has introduced the new "EJBS" shipping service, owned by Emirates Shipping Line, at Jubail Commercial Port. This service connects Saudi Arabia with ports in the UAE and Kuwait.

This new service will help to meet the market demands, support the region's growing trade, and strengthen Saudi Arabia's position as a global logistics hub and a crucial link between three continents, aligned with the National Transport and Logistics Strategy.

The new shipping service connects Jubail Commercial Port with the ports of Jebel Ali in the UAE and Shuwaikh in Kuwait, with a capacity of 1,800 TEUs.

As a crucial port, Jubail Commercial Port plays a vital role in facilitating the export of domestic goods, including industrial products and petrochemicals from Jubail Industrial City, to international markets, thus enhancing Saudi Arabia's competitive position.

SOHAR PORT SIGNS EXPANSION PACT WITH ALLIED ON DOCK CONTAINER SERVICES

SOHAR Port and Freezone is pleased to announce the inauguration of Allied Ondock Container Services, alongside the signing of an expansion agreement valued at approximately \$2.6 million. The new container depot initially covers 3 hectares, with the contract for this development signed in June 2023. Whilst the company inaugurated the first plot, at the same time it has signed a contract for an expansion of an additional 2 hectares. Allied Ondock, a subsidiary of the Singapore-based Allied Container Group, aims to optimise logistics operations by offering a range of services, including container depot, repair, inspection, and washing/cleaning facilities. Allied Ondock will facilitate the transfer of containers from Hutchison Ports Sohar, unloading cargo in their warehouse before returning the empty containers for further dispatch.

SAUDI POST AND SEDA COLLABORATE TO BOOST NON-OIL EXPORTS
