DP WORLD LUANDA ACQUIRES FLEET OF NEW TRACTORS FOR MULTIPURPOSE TERMINAL AT PORT OF LUANDA

DP World Luanda has acquired a fleet of 30 new high-performance tractors, as part of its investment to modernize the Multipurpose Terminal (MPT) at the Port of Luanda, and further improve operational efficiencies. The arrival of the tractors follows the start of operations by DP World Luanda, on 1 March 2021, after it was awarded a 20-year concession to manage and operate the MPT.

Since then, DP World Luanda has implemented several projects and initiatives, as part of its US\$190 million investment over the term of the concession, to transform the terminal into a modern and efficient port facility to help the country achieve its economic growth ambitions. These include staff development and training, the implementation of

new technology, the acquisition of new equipment and the development of new staff facilities at the terminal.

The tractors, being the latest generation Terberg YT223, has proven itself in terminals across the world, and will be used within the yard area of the MPT to move semi-trailers to and from the terminal for loading and unloading.

GRABBER AND GRAPPLES FOR DREDGING

MACHINERY MOVEMENT TO DJIBOUTI BY NAVIGATORS TEAM

NG News desk Dubai: Project cargo movement brings along challenges and excitements equally.

With a proven professionalism and capability in handling time-sensitive cargo movements, the Projects team at Navigators, recently handled a successful movement of 2 units of machinery and its accessories in a meticulously planned project execution. The team comprising of experts in oversized load haulage carried out the movement of the Grabber and Grapples used for Dredging which measured 4 m x 2.4 m x 2.8 m (Dredging clamshell for crawler crane) and 4.55 m x 3.4 m x 3.4 m (Heavy duty mechanical orange peel grapple suitable for crawler crane).

The machinery, which was destined to Djibouti, originated from Sajja, Sharjah where the client was located. To avoid glitches and possible impediments extensive planning was done as usual before the move. The cargo was brought into the Jebel Ali port for the commencement of its onward ocean bound journey on a 40 feet flat rack container. As it was initially mentioned, Project cargo movement can pose



challenges and excitement at any point of time. Here the challenges sprang in the form of a lashing and securing requirement in the zero hour, which was eventually handled by the ground professionals of the Projects team.

"Project cargo shipment involves quite a lot of moving parts, complex timings and careful attention to detail. A team of professionals with positive attitude, conceptualizes these challenges as opportunities to learn. That is how we are lucky at Navigators. ROLLS-ROYCE, CHEFSFRIDGE JOIN FORCES TO DESIGN COLD PODS TO TRANSPORT COVID-19 VACCINES GLOBALLY

Rolls-Royce and ChefsFridge Co. have teamed up to develop an innovative, ultra-low temperature pod to transport and store Covid-19 vaccines globally to meet the challenge of vaccinating patients around the world in nearly any environment.

The new ArcticRx system will help bridge the gap in the cold chain currently challenging the global vaccination effort. ArcticRx is a passive, stable, long-term ultra-low temperature (ULT) pod — the first of its kind to support a two-dose vaccine delivery regimen specifically targeting rural, remote, and international areas supporting global equitable access and help share doses as rapidly and quickly as possible.

The ArcticRx pod was designed by Rolls-Royce innovators in Indianapolis and developed with ChefsFridge, also based nearby. The collaboration has led to a final design, with three models manufactured and tested. With the ability to scale quickly with funding, ChefsFridge Co. is currently seeking investment and manufacturing partners as the team moves forward to market.
