SILO MOVEMENT TO ROTTERDAM**NAVIGATORS ONCE AGAIN PROVED ITS CAPABILITY IN MANAGING TIME BOUND PROJECTS**

NG News desk Dubai, May 2022: Navigators Projects team released details of a recently handled project cargo movement to Rotterdam. 100-ton capacity Silo weighing 23,500 kilograms were moved from Jebel Ali to Rotterdam as per the release. The cargo originated from Ras Al Khaimah was cross stuffed in Jebel Ali and moved in a time bound programme, despite challenges. Non-availability of empty containers at the port posed a major blockade for the movement. The highly experienced and vibrant operations team immediately organized empty container from another terminal and provided critical support to the projects team to successfully manage the movement of the Silo.

Timely intervention of our operations team to organize empty container was a breakthrough for us to meet up with the time committed to the client. We had very little time to mobilize the cargo because it was Out of Gauge (OOG), and the RTA permits were

already in place based on the loading day evening. Rescheduling would have resulted in a minimum of a two-day delay in the entire procedure, as well as a missed vessel cut off which means more time and money. We didn't want our client to suffer, and we decided to travel that extra mile to fulfill our commitment" mentioned Projects head.

Silo was moved from RAK in low-low bed trailer to Jebel Ali for the cross stuffing on to a 40 feet flat rack container at the port CFS, which was a last-minute decision, based on the container availability. The entire project cargo movement was completed as per the time committed and loaded on to the vessel for its onward journey to the port of Rotterdam. The projects team further commented that the client was extremely satisfied with the timely execution of the project despite challenges.

ETIHAD ADDING CAPACITY

Etihad Cargo to add capacity in summer across Asia, Africa, Europe Additional flights in summer to introduce more belly capacity across key routes for Etihad Cargo's customers.

Etihad Cargo, the cargo and logistics arm of Etihad Aviation Group, will provide additional capacity to key destinations in the summer months across Asia, Africa, and Europe. From July, Etihad Cargo will continue to operate its Boeing 777 freighter network with flights across Chicago, Dhaka, Frankfurt, Hanoi, Ho Chi Minh City, Hong Kong, Johannesburg, Kenya, Milan, Riyadh, Saigon, and Shanghai. The carrier will also benefit from additional passenger flights on its Boeing 787 and Airbus 350 with 35 direct flights to London Heathrow, seven direct flights to Bangkok, and five flights to Bangkok via Phuket. Also Read - Turkish Cargo plans to add more capacity to India as production rises Etihad will offer daily flights to Dublin Singapore, and Kuala Lumpur. Additionally, more weekly flights to Barcelona, Brussels, Johannesburg, Madrid, Tokyo, and Vienna have been added to the carrier's summer schedule.

DP WORLD AND CDPQ ANNOUNCE US\$5 BILLION INVESTMENT IN STRATEGIC ASSETS IN THE UAE

DP World and CDPQ, a global investment group, announced today an investment of US\$5 billion (CA\$6.3 billion) in three of DP World's flagship UAE assets.



CDPQ will invest US\$2.5 billion in the Jebel Ali Port, the Jebel Ali Free Zone and the National Industries Park through a new joint venture in which it will hold a stake of approximately 22%, with the remainder of the transaction being financed by debt. Other long-term investors will have the opportunity to acquire an additional stake of up to US\$3 billion. The transaction implies a total enterprise value of approximately US\$23 billion or the three assets.

The Jebel Ali Port, Free Zone and National Industries Park together comprise a best-in-class group of infrastructure with a solid long-term track record of growth. Combined, they form a world-class integrated ecosystem for the supply and logistics chains of over 8,700 companies from around the world, serving more than 3.5 billion people globally. The three assets generated pro-forma 2021 revenue of US\$1.9 billion.
